

Medical Assistant

Job Description:

- Verifies patient information by interviewing patient, records medical history, and confirming purpose of visit
- Prepares patients for examination by performing preliminary physical tests such as taking blood pressure, weight, and temperature, and reports patient history summary
- Secures patient information and maintains patient confidence by completing and safeguarding medical records, completes diagnostic coding and procedure coding, and keeps patient information confidential
- Assists Provider with office procedures such as laceration repairs, mole and wart removals, etc.
- Chaperones Providers during sensitive exams
- Maintains safe, secure, and healthy work environment by establishing and following standards and procedures, and complies with legal regulations
- Keeps supplies ready by inventorying stock, maintains inventory log, notifies
 Officer Manager when supplies are low
- Follows operating instructions for equipment, troubleshoots breakdowns, maintains supplies, performs preventive maintenance, and notifies Office Manager for scheduling repairs
- Updates job knowledge by participating in educational opportunities and reading professional publications

- Serves and protects the Urgent Care facility by adhering to professional standards, policies and procedures, federal, state, and local requirements
- Sanitizes and cleans exam rooms after every patient visit (wipes down exam tables and countertops with disinfectant wipes, changes exam table paper, sprays disinfectant spray (note: must wait 5 minutes after cleaning before placing new patient in the room).
- Ensures exam rooms are well stocked, trash cans are emptied, and supplies are put away at the end of every shift.

Additional Duties:

- 1. Must be proficient at drawing blood
- 2. Must be proficient at performing basic X-Ray imaging studies
- 3. Must be proficient at performing EKG studies on patients (on-site training will be conducted)
- 4. Must be proficient at performing eye exams on patients (visual acuity Snell chart)
- 5. Must be proficient at conducting PFTs, audiogram and other occupational study exams (on-site training will be conducted)
- 6. Must be proficient at performing influenza and strep testing
- 7. Must be proficient at charting accurately on findings
- 8. Must be able to cross-cover laboratory technician duties as needed
- 9. Must be proficient at giving shots (Penicillin shots, steroid shots, Benadryl, etc.)
